

MITIGATION STRATEGIES UTILIZED FOR THE 2022-23 SCHOOL YEAR

Masking	Face masks are not required in school or during transportation on school-provided vehicles.
Cohorts	PK-12– Students will not be placed into cohorts. Intermingling of students will be based on academic necessity in addition to their regular classroom groups.
School Meals	K-12 Grades: Students will be able to eat breakfast and lunch in the cafeteria spaces within buildings.
Ventilation	HVAC systems have been evaluated previously and ventilation has been maximized within our systems availability.
Cleaning Disinfection	Per the CDC, cleaning once a day is sufficient to remove viruses on surfaces. Nightly disinfection of shared spaces.
Volunteers/Visitors	Visitors will be allowed to return to buildings. Visitors should contact building offices prior to arrival whenever possible. Those interested in serving as volunteers must have a complete and valid background check prior to serving in this capacity. Contact building offices for more information.
Building Use	Our buildings are open to outside groups for usage per policy 905.01-R(1) .
COVID Positive Cases	CCA will continue to follow current public health guidelines and recommendations for isolation of students and staff who test positive for COVID.

<p>Instruction during Isolation</p>	<p>The process will be the same as it was prior to the pandemic.</p> <p>PK-5 – Our teacher team will communicate with the student and family about what work the student is missing and support the student/family through the process.</p> <p>Middle School-- Our teacher team will communicate with the student and family about what work the student is missing and support the student/family through the process. Schoology will be a resource that the student/family can use to watch videos of classroom instruction to help facilitate the content.</p> <p>High School-- We would ask the student & parents to work with their teachers on school responsibilities and expectations, Schoology should be utilized.</p> <p>Our teachers will not be providing remote instruction.</p>
<p>Field Trips</p>	<p>Field trips will be allowed to proceed as normal.</p>
<p>Zoned Recess</p>	<p>There will not be zoned/separated recess groups for PK-5th grades.</p>
<p>Athletics/Activities</p>	<p>Follow Professional Organization Guidance from IGHSAU, IAHSAA, IHSMA, etc.</p>
<p>Birthday Snacks/Treats</p>	<p>Pre-packaged for both purchased and homemade items will be allowed. Please consult with your child's teacher for any allergies that may exist within their classroom(s). Snacks/Treats can also be purchased through the District Food Service Department by contacting your child's building.</p>
